COVID-19 Safety Protocols and Club Changes

The Hoboken Sailing Club's first and foremost responsibility is for the safety of our members, students, and general public. The following protocols have been implemented for the remainder of the 2020 sailing season so we can meet that goal.

- Boats will be thoroughly disinfected before and after a voyage. Special attention will be given to the cockpit which is where most members sit while operating the vessel.
- We have increased our fleet by three vessels for a total of nine vessels. This will allow for smaller crew size if the member while still allowing multiple members to enjoy the benefits the club has to offer. Please refer to page 3 for a breakdown of the fleet.
- Membership rates have been reduced due to the delayed opening of the season. Please refer to page 3 for updated rate information.
- All CDC guidelines, as well as state and federal protocols will be followed.

2020 Hoboken Sailing School FAQs

Q. When are the courses offered?

- **Basic Keel Boat**
 - Courses are typically held on Saturdays and Sundays, then again on weekdays based upon availability. Course schedule is subject to change. Please contact us for availability.

- **Performance and Spinnaker Sailing**
 - Courses are typically held over a 3-day weekend (Friday-Sunday) and could be offered on weekdays based upon demand and availability. Course schedule is subject to change. Please contact us for availability.

Q. How long is the course?

- **Basic Keel Boat:**
 - The course is 18 hours over a two-day period along with an online practical to be completed prior to your first day. During the 2 days, you will go over any questions from the online portion of your class and have both in classroom and on the water exercises and instruction.

- **Performance and Spinnaker Sailing:**
 - The course is 24 hours over a three-day period. During the 3 days, there will be both classroom and on the water instruction. This course is geared towards those with sailing experience looking to maximize their skills.

Q. How much does it cost to take a class? - 2020 Hoboken Sailing School Course Rates

- **Basic Keel Boat:**
 - \$500 per person
 - Cost includes study materials and certification

- **Performance and Spinnaker Sailing**
 - \$1,000 per person for the course
 - Cost includes study materials and certification

Membership FAQs

Q. What do I need to do to become a member of The Sailing Club?

Contact George via the email indicated below and make an appointment to have a tour of our facility. Then you will need to provide us a completed membership application along with your payment. Payment can be received as a check, cash or by providing us your credit card information.

Q. How much does it cost to become a member?

- **Individual:** **\$1,066.25** **(\$1,000 plus 6.625% NJ Sales Tax)**
- **Family:** **\$1,599.38** **(\$1,500 plus 6.625% NJ Sales Tax)**

Guests are allowed at an additional \$25.

Q. What are membership requirements?

- To join the club, we require that you have already taken a Basic Keel Boat Course and obtained a NJ State Boating License. If you have not taken a course, we can offer the Basic Keel Boat Course on site.

Q. What does The Club membership include?

Invites to Club sponsored social events, access to Waterfront Bar, and use of our Club boats:

- Four J24s
- Four J80s
- One Archambault Surprise
 - Training will be provided for each class of boat. This will allow you to feel comfortable in any boat you choose to take out.

Q. What if I don't know how to sail?

We are an Accredited US Sailing School. Once you complete the Basic Keel Boat course, you will enough of a background where we can further your practical learning and join the club.

Q. How do I schedule the use of The Club Boats?

You can book your boat in advance on our website though the Peek booking system.
